DESCRIPTION OF AGENCY:

The Department of Energy is authorized to promulgate regulations necessary or incidental to the performance of duties or execution of powers conferred under Title 45.2 of the Code of Virginia in the chapters and articles indicated. Such regulations may be promulgated by the department, the Chief of the Division of Mines, the Virginia Gas and Oil Board or the Director, as appropriate, or with the approval of the director, may be promulgated by any division of the department with respect to matters assigned to that division. Brief Overview		
Recent legislation passed during the 2025 legislative session is the impetus for this regulatory action. HB1887/SB969 amends Code of Virginia to update § 45.2-1200 & § 45.2-1101 regarding the construction or expansion of farm ponds, increasing the farm pond construction or expansion beyond a one-time occurrence and extends the required completion time from 6 months to 1 year. This action aims to update the Admin Code of Virginia to match the updated Code of Virginia language.

Brief Overview		
Recent review of the State Reclamation Plan by OSMRE recognized outdated language not reflecting current practices or federal guidance under 4VAC25-130-882. Federal SMCRA guidance under 30 CFR 882 directs that no lien be placed on property of surface owners who did not consent to participate in reclamation work. Further review of the State Reclamation Plan found that 4VAC25-130-882 misaligns with current agency practices, which does not place liens on properties that have been entered to address environmental issues related to AML. The review of the State Reclamation Plan and recognition of misaligned language prompted the Virginia Department of Energy to amend 4VAC25-13-882 to reflect Federal Guidelines and current practices.

Executive Order No 19 (2022) directed agencies to review regulatory guidance document in an effort to reduce regulatory burden and streamline regulatory processes. The Department of Energy reviewed regulatory guidance related to Safety and Health Regulations for Mineral Mining and found towing guidance unaligned with federal guidance and unnecessarily burdensome. Current language requires use of a tow bar and safety chain to tow heavy equipment that is not being operated under its own power. Federal guidance from MSHA 30 CFR 56.14209.(a) lessons regulatory burden for mine operators by providing additional pathways to compliance without threatening safety. This regulatory action would update language to reflect federal guidance and reduces regulatory burdens. Updated language would reflect federal regulatory documents by providing the option for "other effective and safe means of control".
